The City Transfer Charge will be modified as necessary to provide a matching of the total mandated transfers and/or expenses set forth by the Governing Body of the City of McPherson, Kansas.

DEFINITION RESIDENTIAL USE:

For water service supplied to a single-family residential location (one (1) customer through one (1) metering point) for domestic use and watering of customer's lawn. Qualifying establishments do not include campers or other temporary living quarters, mobile home parks with master meters, apartment complexes with master meters, multi-family buildings with master meters, churches, and others. Service is for exclusive use of customer, and is not to be resold or shared with others.

Where five (5) or more rooms in a residence are rented, or are available for rent, such residences shall be considered as commercial rooming houses and billed as "Commercial."

GENERAL NOTE:

In the event the customer orders a disconnection and reconnection of water at the same premise within a period of twelve (12) months, the BPU may collect as a reconnection charge the sum of such minimum bills as would have accrued during the period of disconnection.

For customers located outside the city limits, BPU will designate meter location which typically is adjacent to existing water main. Customer shall be responsible for installing water line from the meter to the point of usage. The charge for this service shall be the "Outside City Limits" charge.

In the interest of water conservation, indiscriminate waste of water by the customer will be grounds for temporary discontinuation of water service by the utility. It will be the customer's responsibility to demonstrate corrective measures that will stop excessive waste of water resources.

NOTES:

Effective January 1, 2019 Water Rate Schedule WAT-19 replaces Water Rate Schedule WAT-18 which was effective January 1, 2018.
